The overarching objective of the program is to increase the number of Canadian students studying and working internationally.

Funded Destinations:

Funding is available for all destinations globally outside of Canada; however, funding is prioritized for students planning to work in non-traditional countries. Non-traditional countries are countries other than the US, UK, France and Australia. Students are permitted to work in these non-traditional countries, however they will receive slightly reduced funding from the Global Skills Opportunity fund, as funding is more readily available for non-traditional countries as outlined by CICan.
